THE world's bestknown valet, Jeeves, comes to The Mayflower theatre this year, to get his boss Bertie Wooster out of yet another scrape. Bertie is a rather gormless member of the idle rich.

My Man Jeeves' is a collection of short stories by P. G. Wodehouse. It was first published in the United Kingdom in 1919. Of the eight stories in the collection, half feature the popular characters Jeeves and Bertie Wooster, while the others concern Reggie Pepper, an early prototype for Wooster.

A collection of stories in which familiar characters and places are reintroduced in unfamiliar circumstances, reminding us - if we need reminding - of their author's limitless powers of comic invention. In the title story - one of Wodehouse's longest and best shorter fictions - Lord Emsworth takes his revenge on his ghostly secretary, the Efficient Baxter, setting off a wave of similar reprisals at Blandings Castle with amazing results.
